It provides a unique and special place for these young children to escape their daily environment of hospitals, medications, pain and the discomfort associated with cancer and its treatment. Kamp features a wide range of activities and entertainment while each camper is "medically supervised" by our team of doctors and nurses.

Kay's Kamp is the dream and last wish of Kaylyn Warren who was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia in October of 2005 at the age of 17. Kay battled cancer with dignity and grace until her struggle with leukemia ended on March 13, 2007.

## Our Mission:

The mission of Kay's Kamp is to provide children ages 5-17 currently battling cancer and those now in remission the opportunity to participate in a unique camping experience promoting fun and normalcy, **Free of Charge**



## Kampers

Any child ages 5-17 who is undergoing cancer treatment or is in remission, may attend with the approval of their physician. We also offer a *Day Kamp* program for those kampers not ready to spend the night.



## Staff

Our staff is a dedicated group of volunteers, 21 years and older, consisting of parents, teachers, survivors, young adults and professionals who are committed to helping kids with cancer. All staff are CPR certified and required to stay at Kamp for the entire week.

## LIT

Our *Leader in Training* program is an opportunity for young adults, ages 18-20, that are currently in treatment or a cancer survivor to be trained as our future staff.

## Medical

Our medical team, on site at all times, includes pediatric physicians, RN's, oncology nurses, an oncology pharmacist and nurse practitioners from Christiana Care, The Helen F. Graham Cancer Center, Al Dupont and other area hospitals. Phone consultation is available 24 hours a day by pediatric oncologists at Al Dupont Hospital for Children .

Kay's Kamp will be held at St. Andrew's School in Middletown, Delaware - August 7-14, 2010. (Kampers arrive on the 8th)
