Kaylyn, a 17 year old high school senior at Red Lion Christian Academy, had been accepted at the University of Delaware's Hotel, Restaurant & Institutional Management Program for the fall of 2006. She had a dream of starting a B&B when she graduated, but in a split second on October 15, 2005 life changed forever when Kay was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. She learned quickly that cancer and its treatment had stolen the normalcy of her young life and the dream of a B&B soon changed to a dream of opening a summer camp for kids with cancer. Kay loved to camp and this would be the perfect place for kids dealing with cancer to have fun and feel normal in their now not-so-normal lives. When Kaylyn came home with hospice care she knew she wouldn't be able to open the camp herself and asked that we fulfill her dream. Kay battled cancer with dignity and grace until March 13, 2007 when her struggle with leukemia ended and she was healed to eternal life.

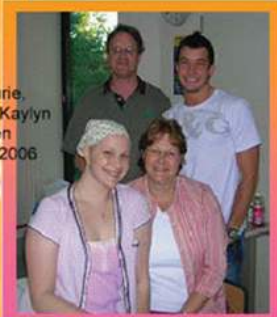

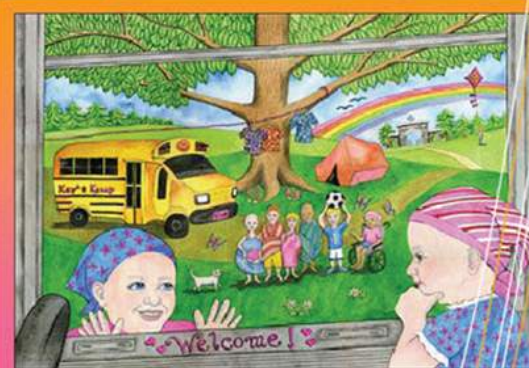
